Prof. Fischer is a professor of Pediatric Immunology at the University Paris Descartes and former director of the Institute for Genetic Diseases (Imagine) at Necker University Hospital, Paris, France.

Prof. Fischer is a fellow of the French Academy of Sciences and French Academy of Medicine, he is also a member of the European Molecular Biology Organization.

[Brief Introduction]

Prof. Fischer's main research interests are in gene therapy, genetics of immunological disorders, primary immunodeficiency diseases, and the development of the lymphoid system. Over the last 15 years, he and his colleagues have analyzed the mechanisms of hereditary diseases of the immune system.

Prof. Fischer received the Louis Jeantet Prize for Medicine in 2001, The Robert Koch Prize 2014 and the Japan Prize 2015.
